

**Village of Holmen
Park, Recreation, and Library Committee
Meeting Minutes - Wednesday, June 3, 2026**

Committee Chair Wyss called the Holmen Park, Recreation, and Library Committee meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. on June 3, 2026 at Holmen Village Hall.

Present: Micah Wyss, Sam Kube, Chris Geary, Alex Inglett

Absent: Dawn Kulcinski, Chris McArdle-Rojo

Motion by Kube, second by Wyss to approve the minutes of the May 6, 2026 meeting. Carried unanimously.

Public Comment: None.

Library Director's monthly report: None.

Park and Recreation Director's monthly report:

Recreation: Director Geary informed the committee the Viking Soccer Academy, the youth soccer tournament, traveling soccer, adult fitness classes and Impact volleyball have all completed for the spring. He also mentioned most summer programs begin next week. Geary also stated the Concerts in the Park start June 7 and the first Movie in the Park of the year will be Friday, June 5.

Parks: Director Geary informed the committee that staff have been extremely busy with daily shelter cleaning. He also told the committee the Remington dugout project has been completed. Lastly, Geary mentioned softball and baseball games started this week. Kube asked what the schedule for cleaning shelters looks like for staff. Geary answered there are two part time staff that work hard on early weekend mornings before shelters open to get them cleaned and turned over for the next group. Kube mentioned the men's and women's restrooms were closed at Seven Bridges Park and asked if that was the norm. Geary replied that there has been a lot of vandalism in those restrooms so staff keep them locked for the most part unless there are games or tournaments being held, but the family restroom is open during park hours.

Aquatic Center: Geary reminded the committee that the pool opens on June 6 and closes August 16. He also stated that Parkitecture will be visiting the aquatic center on June 19. Lastly, he informed the committee that staff had to purchase a new refrigerator and freezer because the old ones were no longer working.

The committee reviewed possible action and recommendation on the special event request by Holmen American Legion for Kornfest on August 14-16, 2026 at Halfway Creek Park. Director Geary informed the committee that the Park & Recreation Department charges the Legion \$200.00 for the use of the park and bandshell for the week. The Department also asks for a \$2,000.00 deposit. He explained that the Holmen American Legion gets the deposit back if no damages are assessed within the park. Wyss asked if anything was different on this year's application. Geary explained it was the same as year's past.

Motion by Kube, second by Wyss to recommend to the Board the approval of the special event request by Holmen American Legion for Kornfest on August 14-16, 2026 at Halfway Creek Park. Carried unanimously.

Other Business: None.

Motion by Kube, second by Wyss to adjourn at 5:20 p.m. Motion carried.
