

**Registration:**

Before casting a ballot in the November General Election, you must be registered to vote. If you have an up-to-date WI driver license or ID you can register online at <https://myvote.wi.gov/en-us/> by **October 16, 2024.**



Missed the deadline to register to vote online or by mail? You can still register in our office by *Friday November 1, 2024*, or at your polling place on November 5, 2024!

**Absentee Ballot Request:**

Registered, eligible WI voters can use <https://myvote.wi.gov/en-us/> to request an absentee ballot and submit a copy of their acceptable photo ID. Requests for absentee ballots must be received by **October 31, 2024 at 5pm.**



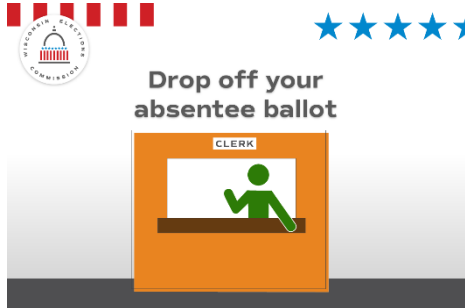
**In Person Absentee Voting:**

**Return Absentee Ballot:**

Absentee ballots must arrive by **8 p.m. on November 5, 2024** to be counted. Please keep in mind, you must return your own absentee ballot per State law.



**Last day to register in office:**

November 1, 2024, is the last day to register to vote in our office for the November 5, 2024 election! 8:00am-5:00pm at Village Hall. **Reminder: Monday November 4, 2024 is Election Administration Day and no registration can occur. The only absentee activity that day will be the return of absentee ballots that were previously mailed to voter.**
