REFUSE & RECYCLING RATE: \$46.00/quarter

Inquire with waste hauler on disposal rates for mattresses, box springs, electronics and appliances.

WATER RATE: \$18.00/quarter service charge (3/4" meter)
\$ 2.25/thousand gallons (residential)

PUBLIC FIRE PROTECTION: Quarter service charge based on meter size--3/4" = \$14.10/quarter (including developed and undeveloped properties)

SEWER RATE:

Debt Service

Average Residence uses 10,100 gallons
Average Residence = 1 REC*
1 REC = \$15.50/quarter

*Each Commercial/Industrial/Public Authority account is assigned a number of RECs based on past year usage compared to Average Residential Usage

Operation & Maintenance

\$8.00/thousand gallons used**

**Revenue needed for O & M divided by number of gallons sold for prior year determines per thousand rate

(The figures for Average Residential Usage/REC Rate/and O & M rate per thousand are computed each year.)

Residences Only

2nd & 3rd quarters (March reading-September reading) rate is based on prior 4th quarter usage if less than actual. For new customers, an Average Customer Usage is used for 2nd & 3rd quarter sewer billing.

STORMWATER RATE: \$ 0.00/ERU Base Charge (BC)
\$12.00/ERU Runoff Unit Charge

*Stormwater rates are adjusted each year. Charges are based on average estimated impervious area of a residential parcel. Minimum charge per improved parcel = 1 BC and 1 ERU charge.

RESIDENCES ONLY:

Large item pick-up is available bi-weekly on Thursdays to residents of the Village. If Thursday is a holiday, pick-up is usually on Friday (reference annual recycling newsletter). Residents are required to call the hauler to arrange for pickup. Please place items in the same location as your regular refuse by 5 a.m. the day of pickup. Types of items that can be disposed of are: dressers, televisions, tires, couches, chairs, mattresses and box springs (fee applies/payable to hauler), carpet (no longer than 4 ft. in length, tied securely on both ends, under 60 pounds in weight), etc. E-waste, white goods, mattresses and box springs are collected bi-weekly on Thursdays. Residents are required to call the refuse hauler in advance and pay a fee per item prior to collection of these items. Type of white goods that can be disposed of are: window air conditioners, washers, dishwashers, stoves, freezers, refrigerators, dryers, microwave ovens, water heaters, etc. **Demolition materials and debris from remodeling or construction projects are not accepted.**

Check Recycler for guidelines on disposal of branches, brush, shrubs, Christmas trees, yard and garden waste.
